ELECTION BOARD MEETING MINUTES

March 4, 2024

The first order of business was to review the proposed Vote Center locations. Shari J. Lentz advised the board that the rental fee to use Donner Center for absentee voting will be \$4,900 and that the rental fee to use NexusPark for set-up and Election Day will be \$1,000.

Mark Kevitt made a motion to accept all proposed Vote Center Locations. Shari Lentz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The board signed the order adopting the 2024 Vote Center locations that will be utilized in this year's election cycle. The board selected the following locations for the 2024 Primary and General Elections:

Early Voting locations were set at Donner Center and Barth. Co. Governmental Office Bldg.

Shari J. Lentz suggested that all future campaign finance delinquency letters be sent via service by sheriff guaranteeing good service. The board agreed unanimously.
