

COMMISSIONERS' MEETING

December 2, 2013

The Bartholomew County Commissioners met in regular session on December 2, 2013 in the Governmental Office Building, 440 Third Street, Columbus, Indiana. Chairman Carl Lienhoop called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Commissioners Larry Kleinhenz and Rick Flohr, County Attorney J. Grant Tucker and Auditor Barbara Hackman were also in attendance.

Commissioner Kleinhenz gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item on the agenda was the approval of the November 25, 2013 Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Kleinhenz made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Flohr, and the motion passed unanimously.

Next item on the agenda was the approval of Claims. Commissioner Flohr made a motion to approve the Claims as presented, seconded by Commissioner Kleinhenz, and the motion passed unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was the weekly Permit report. Chairman Lienhoop read the New Permits Report dated 11/25/13 to 11/30/2013. Nineteen (19) permits had been issued with a fee amount of \$2,940 and an estimated construction cost of \$1,574,100. Fees collected for the month of November were \$13,107.

County Engineer Danny Hollander gave the weekly crew report which included the following work: mowed in Harrison & Wayne Townships, patched roads, installed three sandboxes and will do three more on Thursday, and worked on Whitehorse Rd.

Chris Walls, owner of 39 Degrees North of Bloomington, IN, presented statistics and patterns of usage of eGIS for 2013 with comparisons to the previous year.
