The Bartholomew County Council met on May 9, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the County Council Chambers of the Governmental Office Building, 440 Third Street, Columbus, Indiana.

President Mark Gorbett called the meeting to order.

Attorney Chris Monroe gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item on the agenda was the approval of meeting minutes of April 10, 2018. Jorge Morales made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Laura DeDomenic seconded the motion which passed unanimously (5-0).

(Bill Lentz joined the meeting)

The next item on the agenda was a was a Request for an Additional Appropriation for Statewide 911 Fund (122) in the amount of eighteen-thousand nine-hundred-one dollars and twenty cents (\$18,901.20) as presented by E911 Director Todd Noblitt and Deputy Director Julie Pierce. Twelve-thousand nine-hundred-one dollars (\$12,900)

would be for salary adjustments made at the end of 2017 and six-thousand (\$6,000) would be to hire Barry Ritter, Consultant, to review the purchase of a new 911 system. Jorge Morales made a motion to approve the request as presented. Matt Miller seconded the motion which passed unanimously (6-0).

The next item on the agenda was a Request for an Additional Appropriation for the Rental Payment Fund (351) in the amount of ninety-two-thousand dollars (\$92,000) as presented by Auditor Hackman. Auditor Hackman presented a handout with the income from rentals as well as any expenditure items. The balance at the end of the year will be the ninety-two-thousand dollars (\$92,000). They have disbursed thirteen-thousand five-hundred-forty-seven dollars and twenty-six cents (\$13,547.26). The expenditures do not include paving to be done and any unplanned maintenance costs. Laura DeDomenic asked what the Condo fees are going to. She believes that the roof and paving should be covered by this. Matt Miller doesn't believe we should be responsible for the HVAC with a standard lease. Jorge Morales made a motion to approve the request for fifteen-thousand dollars (\$15,000) to cover the expenses already spent and that the Auditor follows up with the above questions. Laura DeDomenic seconded the motion which passed unanimously (6-0).

The next item on the agenda was a Request for an Addition Appropriation for the WRAP RSAT Grant (032) in the amount of seventy-seven-thousand seven-hundred dollars and seventy-three cents (\$77,700.73) as presented Residential Work Release Director Rob Gaskill. They have received this Grant since 2011. There is an in-kind

match that they pay for out of the Community Grant. President Gorbett asked about a men's program. They have been told that they could provide an amount but it is not enough to get the program going. President Gorbett asked that he contact Pastor Tikee to inform him of the amounts to see if they can help out. Laura DeDomenic motioned to approve the request as presented. Jorge Morales seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was a Request for a Transfer of Funds for the Bartholomew County Immunization Program Fund (811) from 02-40 to 04-40 in the amount of one-thousand three-hundred dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$1,300.67) as presented by Director of Nursing Amanda Organist. This will be used to purchase a refrigerator for vaccines. Jorge Morales motioned to approve the request as presented. Laura DeDomenic seconded the motion which passed unanimously (6-0).

The next item on the agenda was a Request for an Addition Appropriation for the Bartholomew County Immunization Program Fund (811) in the amount of fifty-seventhousand three-hundred-three dollars and three cents (\$57,303.03) as presented by Director of Nursing Amanda Organist. This is carry-over money from the State from the 2017 budget as well as this year's budget amount. Laura DeDomenic motioned to approve the request as presented. Matt Miller seconded the motion which passed unanimously (6-0).

Regarding the Rental Payment Fund, Auditor Hackman asked that they table the remaining amount of the Rental Payment Fund in the amount of seventy-seven-thousand

dollars (\$77,000). Jorge Morales made a motion to table the amount of seventy-seventhousand dollars (\$77,000). Bill Lentz seconded the motion which passed unanimously (6-0).

The next item on the agenda was an Appointment to the Substance Abuse Public Funding Board. Jorge Morales motioned to appointment Laura DeDomenic as the appointee for a three (3) year term. Mark Gorbett seconded the motion which passed five to zero (5-0-1) with one abstention (*Laura DeDomenic*).
