

ELECTION BOARD MEETING MINUTES

May 13, 2022

1:00 P.M.

Those in attendance: James Holland (Chairman), Mark Kevitt (Vice-Chairman), Peter King (Attorney), Shari J. Lentz (Secretary), and Taylor Seegraves (Elections Administrator)

Chairman, James Holland reconvened the meeting that was recessed on Election Night, May 3, 2022.

The minutes from the Election Night meeting were provided to the board by Taylor Seegraves.

Taylor Seegraves gave the board a report regarding the PRE-16 form that was submitted by the Inspectors on Election Day. It was also noted that the individuals who voted by provisional ballot did produce the necessary documentation to the Voter Registration Office therefore the board unanimously agreed to add the provisional ballots to the vote total.

The board acknowledged the fourteen ballots received after the deadline.

The board discussed new process ideas to assist poll workers with completing the end of the night tasks. The possibility of purchasing new high-speed printers or replacement parts were discussed due to some aging issues.

James Holland then made the motion to certify the election results for the 2022 Primary Election. Mark Kevitt seconded the motion. The board's certification of results was unanimous.

Shari J. Lentz presented the board with an available location within NexusPark to use for the 2022 General Election during early voting. Mark Kevitt motioned to use the proposed location and entrance for the 2022 General Election. Shari J. Lentz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Options were discussed for assisting voters at the new early voting location including but not limited to wheelchair availability and directing voters to the proper location. Shari J. Lentz motions to staff NexusPark entrance with greeter to provide direction and wheelchair assistance. Mark Kevitt seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned by acclamation.
