

ELECTION BOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 8, 2022

ELECTION EVENING

Those in attendance James Holland (Chairman), Mark Kevitt (Vice-Chairman), Peter King (Attorney), and Taylor Seegraves (Elections Administrator)

Chairman, Jim Holland called the meeting to order.

The board reviewed and accepted twelve unsigned Absentee Ballots that had ABS-18As returned. The board is placing the nine remaining unsigned absentee ballots that have not had the ABS-18As returned under Provisional status to be reviewed on November 18, 2022 if valid paperwork is returned timely.

The board reviewed eleven spoiled ballots for which voters were given the opportunity to vote again. Those also reviewed were two voters were deceased that never returned their ballots and six ABS-5 where the voter chose to vote in person rather than the mail ballot that was sent to them.

The election board received four provisional ballots on election night and preliminary discussion took place about each circumstance. Two provisional ballots will need further discussion, one is awaiting proper documentation, and the last situation involving poll worker error will be accepted with both voters involved receiving proper vote history in the statewide system.

Mark Kevitt informed the board that he will not be able to attend the meeting on November 18th and has designated Bob Hyatt as his proxy.

With no further business to discuss, the board agreed to recess the meeting until Friday, November 18th at noon when they will certify the 2022 General Election Results.
