PREA comparison 2019, 2020, and 2021

At the conclusion of each consecutive calendar year between 2019 and 2021, the Survey of Sexual Victimization was completed with aggregated data collection. The results of the finding for each calendar year will be explained along with what policy, procedural or funding changes were made to address issues that may have contributed to these allegations and the actions of those involved.

In 2019, there were zero (0) reports of nonconsensual sexual acts, abusive sexual contact, and sexual harassment made. Nor were 3rd party allegations made. Meaning that it is believed that no PREA boundary had been crossed and zero investigations were conducted.

In 2020, there were zero (0) reports of nonconsensual sexual acts, abusive sexual contact, and sexual harassment made. Nor were 3rd party allegations made. Meaning that it is believed that no PREA boundary had been crossed and zero investigations were conducted. Through grant funding two ipads were purchased to provide for virtual courts, virtual visitation, and virtual service provider appointment resulting in a reduction of searches being conducted on youth.

In 2021, there were zero (0) reports of nonconsensual sexual acts, abusive sexual contact, and sexual harassment made. Nor were 3rd party allegations made. Meaning that it is believed that no PREA boundary had been crossed and zero investigations were conducted.

All staff are required to complete some sort of PREA/Sexual Harassment/Boundary training annually as well as mandatory full PREA training. Team meetings about PREA implementation and policies have been conducted.
